



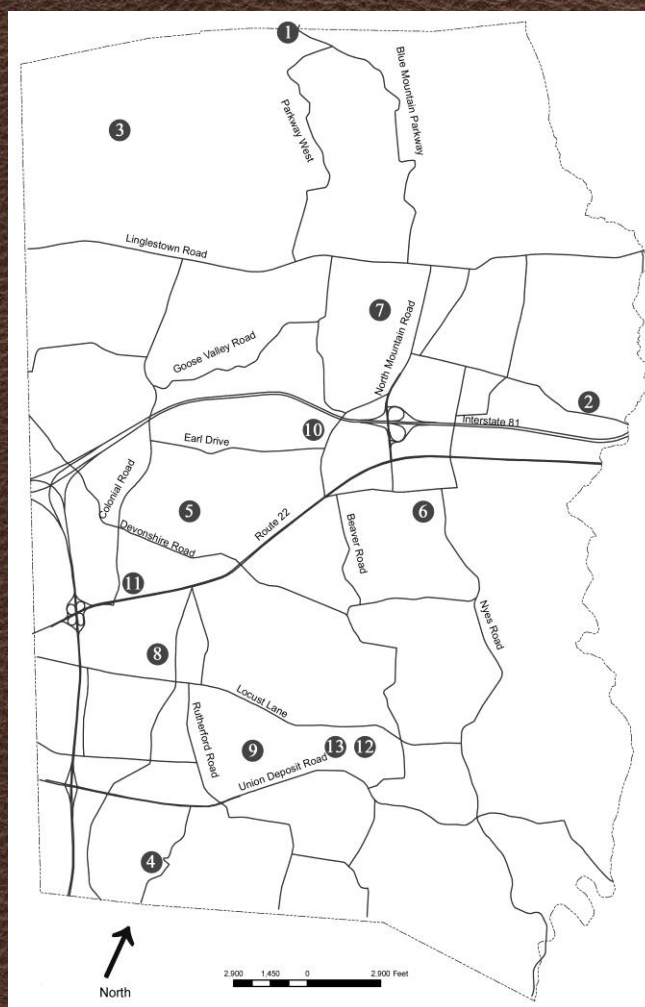
A guide to locations in Lower Paxton Township that provide safe and interesting opportunities for walking, jogging or just “taking a short stroll”.

Walking is a low-impact physical activity with a high-impact payoff in an individual’s health.

We are fortunate to have easy access to many nearby trails and paths in all areas of the Township. They are separate from vehicular traffic, sometimes winding through natural areas or on improved surfaces outside and indoors.

Many of these walkways are located on private property, so:

- Stay on the trail
- Do wear good walking shoes
- Don't litter
- Don't cut or remove any plants
- Do have a good time

1. Darlington Trail at Hocker Park 1.76m M

- Unimproved pathway along crest of Blue Mountain
- Off-street parking
- Trail connections west to Boyd's Big Tree Preserve

Directions: Rt. 39 to Blue Mountain Parkway, to Blue Mountain summit. Park is on the left.

2. Rockford Heights Trail .22m D

- Unimproved pathway
- Short ravine trail with turnaround
- On-street parking

Directions: Rt. 22 to N Mountain Road to Rt. 39, right on Blue Ridge Ave, left onto Rockford Drive. Trail entrance on left.

3. Forest Hills Trail .36 m. D

- Unimproved pathway
- Short loop trail
- On-street parking

Directions: Rt. 39 to Forest Hills Drive, right on Continental Drive. Trail entrance on left.

4. Oscar Lingle Trail at Kohl and Lingle

Parks 2 trails .92 m total M

- Trail network with loop
- Unimproved pathway
- Off-street parking at Kohl Park

Directions: Union Deposit Road to Dowhower Road. Park entrance on right. Trail entrances off parking lot.

5. Brightbill Park Trail .80 m E

- Short loop trail around the park
- Off-street parking
- Mostly gravel/paved pathway, woodlot segment unimproved

Directions: Rt. 22 to Carolyn Street. Park entrance on left. Trail starts along parking lot.



Walking Difficulty Key: .xx m is length of trail in miles

E - Easy M - Moderate D - Difficult

6. George Park Nature Trail .47 m E

- Short, paved pathway with educational signage concerning adjacent wetland
- ADA accessible
- Off-street parking

Directions: Rt. 22 to S. Mountain Road, left on Old Jonestown, then right on Nye's Road. George Park entrance on right.

7. Linglestown Elementary and Middle School Track .25 m E

- Quarter-mile gravel running track
- Off-street parking

Directions: N. Mountain Road toward Linglestown, school is on left, track in rear.

8. Landis Field Track at CD Middle School .25 m E

- Quarter-mile synthetic track with grass fields adjacent
- Off-street parking

Directions: Rt. 22 to South Houcks Road. Right on Locust Lane. School two blocks on right.

9. CD East Middle School Track .25 m E

- Quarter-mile gravel track
- Off-street parking

Directions: Rutherford Road to CD East High School entrance, travel past High School to CD East Middle School on left, track in rear.

10. Mountain View Elementary School Fitness Trail .15 m E

- Paved loop trail around ball fields
- Off-street parking

Directions: From Rt. 22, take left onto Lockwillow Ave, left on Freedom Street, school entrance at street end.



11. Colonial Park Mall .55 m E

- Indoor paved walking
- ADA accessible
- Off-street parking
- Year-around mall walking 7:00 am - 9:00 pm daily.

Directions: Corner of Rt 22 and Colonial Road.

12. Dauphin Co. Tech. School Soccer Field 1.14 m E

- Grass field with sidewalks on two sides
 - Off-street parking
- Directions: Corner of Locust Lane and Fairmount Rd.

13. Dauphin Co. Tech. School Nature Trail .50 m E

- School maintained trail
 - Off-street parking
- Direction: Corner of Locust Lane and Fairmount Rd,
Trail entrance at SW corner of school property.
